Crochet Stitch Glossary (UK Terms)

ch (chain): The foundation stitch — creates a length to work into.

sl st (slip stitch): A joining stitch, no height added.

dc (double crochet): Short, dense stitch (called sc in US terms).

htr (half treble crochet): Mid-height stitch, great for texture (hdc in US).

tr (treble crochet): Taller stitch, creates drape (dc in US).

dtr (double treble crochet): Very tall stitch, airy and open.

rnd (round): A circular row of stitches.

sp (space): The gap between stitches or chains.

st (stitch): The loops of yarn you work into.
